

## Unique Conifer Grafts donated by Gee Farms

*These two year grafts have not yet been introduced into the trade! ONLY available through the ACS.*

*Pinus mugo* 'Top South' One of four brooms on *Pinus mugo* 'Mops' found in the gardens at Gee Farms.

*Abies balsamea* 'Mighty Tightly' Found in northern Michigan by Bill Barger and Gary Gee [B&G] on one of their brooming trips. A very tight conical broom.

*Picea glauca* 'Low Boy' Found in Michigan's Upper Peninsula as a small white spruce at ground level on a 2017 "brooming" trip with Henk van Kempen, Peter Schrauwen, Scott Antrim, Bill Barger and Gary Gee.

*Picea mariana* '20 Mile Hike' A WB discovered by Joe Braeu and Josh Horkey in Northern Minnesota.

*Picea glauca* 'Montmorency' Found in Montmorency County, Northern Michigan by B&G.

*Picea mariana* 'Moose Junction' Found in Northern Minnesota by Josh Horkey and Joe Braeu.

*Picea abies* 'Biggy' Found in the Gee Gardens by Brigetta Stewart from Arrow Alpines. Brigetta's nick name, by Bob, was Biggy. This broom being on Acrocona has cones on tips of its branches.

*Larix laricina* 'Coney Baby' A WB Found by B&G in Upper Peninsula of Michigan, loaded with small cones.
